Highland Christian Families,

COVID-19 hit hard and we are particularly disappointed in the impact it has had on Highland Christian School. HCS is an active community where students grow in stature, wisdom, and an understanding of their heavenly Father. It is with great disappointment that we have not been able to gather with your cherished children but, as we know, the hallmark of an effective school is its ability to adapt and embrace flexibility in order to rise above adversity.

We are very pleased with the quick response and the extensive effort our teachers invested to prepare materials for the first two weeks of E-learning. We also greatly appreciate YOUR involvement and flexibility as we continue to partner with you for your students best!

Unfortunately, at this time, Governor Holcomb has ordered all academic institutions to close until Monday, May 4, 2020.

**During this extended closure, K-8 students will participate in their normal classes** *remotely.* This will require some changes in our approach to eLearning. For the past week, HCS's administrative team has been hard at work putting new technological systems in place to support these changes upon our return from Spring Break. The foundation of this remote instruction and assessment is twofold: teacher led instruction (that can be viewed at a child's convenience) and live Zoom teacher support.

## **Kindergarten - 5th Grade Instruction:**

- Teachers will be creating instructional resources (in the form of videos) or using other
  web-enabled resources to provide teacher-led instruction at home. These resources will
  be stored in OnCampus and will be ready for your child on Mondays, Wednesdays, and
  Fridays.
- Each K-5 student will have a 20 minute scheduled one-on-one conference with their teacher each week using Zoom.
- Full-time Discovery Center (DC) students will continue to receive support from Mrs. Acterhof.
- Students that receive Targeted Instruction support (TI) will continue to receive support from Mrs. Flory via Zoom.

#### 6th-8th Grade Instruction:

 Teachers will be creating instructional resources (in the form of videos) or using other web-enabled resources to provide teacher-led instruction at home. These resources will be stored in OnCampus and will be ready for your child on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays.

- Discovery Center (DC) students will continue to receive support from Mrs. Vant Hoff.
- Class collaboration sessions will be offered via Zoom. This will be communicated by individual teachers.

## Pick-Up/Drop-Off (Wednesday, April 8 from 3pm - 6pm)

- Additional resources (Leveled Reading resources, Jr. High literature books, art projects, student supply bins, etc.) will be prepared for your child.
- Completed Library books should be returned.
- Completed student work (specifically worksheets, packets of work, should be returned), so they can be properly assessed. These assignments will be a part of the third quarter report cards, which will be ready for parents on April 22.

## How will this process work?

- Parents will drive to the front of Highland Christian where they will be met by a staff member. You will drop-off completed work and receive the other essential items needed for the month of April. In this process, you will never need to leave your car!

#### 2019-2020 School Calendar:

#### A few notes:

- 1. Highland Christian will be implementing a 3/2 calendar. *This means that we are delivering 5 days of instruction on three days of the week (Monday, Wednesday, Friday)*.
  - a. Instruction on these days will include one to two days "worth" of material. This will provide families flexibility when work is completed, how technological resources in the house are managed, and teachers time to adequately plan instructionally rich activities, grade student work, and assess student progress.

# Are there any changes to tuition expenditures:
